PART A — OVERVIEW

1 What is the Configuration Module?

The Configuration module is the master setup area of LabCare OPS Central. Before any workflow can begin — quotations, orders, inventory, assembly — the system must first be set up correctly. This module lets the administrator:

- Add and manage system users (staff who log in to LabCare OPS Central)
- Define products that the company sells and assembles
- Define components (raw materials) used in assembly
- Set up factories where products are manufactured
- Set up stores that handle product and component stock
- Register vendors who supply components to the company

Think of it as: Setting up Configuration is like setting up a new office — you register the people, the buildings, the suppliers, and the goods before any actual work starts.

2 Who Can Access Configuration?

All Configuration screens (Add User, Add Product, Add Component, Add Factory, Add Store, Add Vendor) are accessible by SuperAdmin only.

Important: If you are not a SuperAdmin, you will see an "Unauthorised Access" message. Contact your SuperAdmin to make any changes.

3 How to Open Configuration

1. Log in with your SuperAdmin credentials.
2. Look at the left-side navigation menu and click "Configuration".
3. A sub-menu expands showing all available screens: Users, Products, Components, Factories, Stores, Vendors.
4. Click on the screen you need.

PART B — USER MANAGEMENT

4 Add a New User

Every person who logs in to LabCare OPS Central must be added as a user. Steps:

5. Click "Add New User" from the Configuration menu.
6. Fill in all required fields (marked with *).
7. Select the correct Role for the user.
8. If Role = Store Person, select the Store(s) they work in.
9. If Role = Factory, select the Factory they belong to.
10. Enter a Password and Confirm Password (follow Section 6 rules).

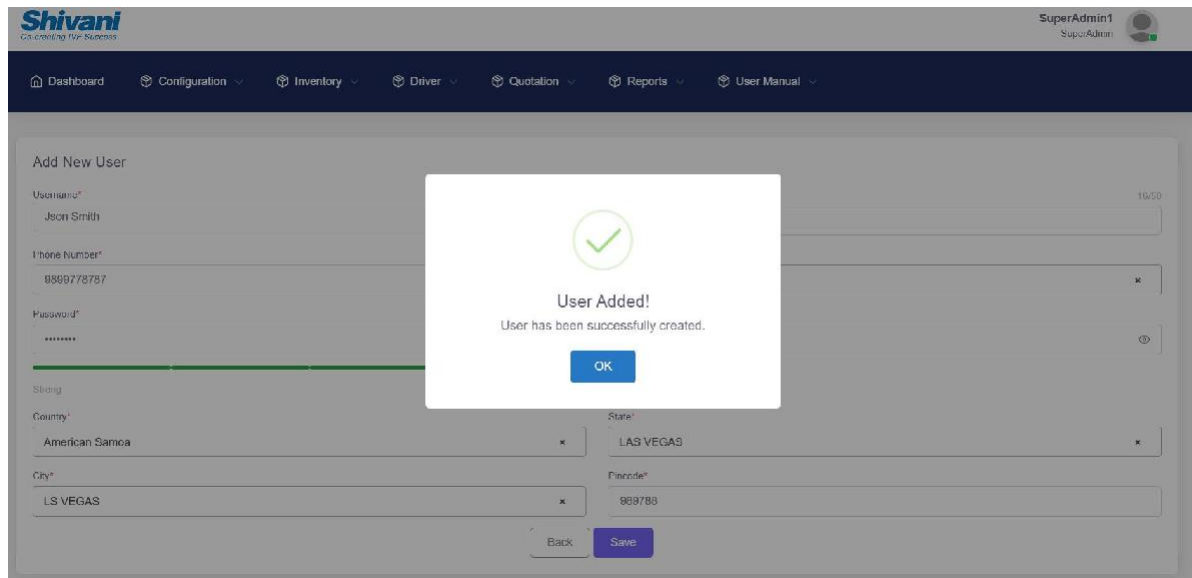

5 Password Rules

The password must follow ALL of these rules:

Rule	Example
At least 8 characters long	Minimum 8 characters
At least one UPPERCASE letter	LabCare OPS Central@2026 → P is uppercase
At least one lowercase letter	LabCare OPS Central@2026 → rofert is lowercase

At least one number (0–9)	LabCare OPS Central@2026 → 2026 is the number
At least one special character (@ # ! \$ _)	LabCare OPS Central@2026 → @ is special

Good example: "LabCare OPS Central@2026" — has uppercase, lowercase, number, and special character.

Note: On the Edit User page, leave Password and Confirm Password blank if you do not want to change the current password.

6 Role-Based Store / Factory Assignment

Role Selected	What Appears	Action Required
Store Person	Store dropdown	Select the store(s) this person works in. They can only see that store's data.
Factory	Factory dropdown	Select the factory this person belongs to. They can only see that factory's data.
All other roles	Nothing extra	No store/factory assignment needed.

7 Edit / View / Delete a User

- Edit: Go to Configuration → User List → Click the pencil (Edit) icon → Update fields → Save.
- View: Go to Configuration → User List → Click the eye (View) icon → See full profile and QR code → Print QR if needed.
- Delete: Go to Configuration → User List → Click the delete icon → Confirm deletion. The user is removed from the system and can no longer log in.

Be careful: Deleting a user is permanent. If the user has active assignments or pending tasks, resolve those first before deleting.

8 User Roles Explained

Role	Who Is This?	What They Can Do
SuperAdmin	System administrator	Full access. Manages users, products, factories, stores, vendors. Views all data.
Labcare Admin	Management / approval person	Approves/rejects quotations, assigns orders to stores, views all reports.
Backend Person	Sales / quotation team	Raises and finalises quotations, answers queries. Cannot approve.
Store Person	Staff at a store location	Manages store inventory, accepts orders, creates inward/outward, raises requisitions.
Factory	Staff at a factory	Receives requisitions, generates QR codes, assigns assembly, manages factory inward/outward.
Floor Person	Assembly worker on factory floor	Floor User Monitor Dashboard only. Scans badge and QR codes to complete assembly tasks.
Main Store	Staff at central warehouse	Manages central component inventory, fulfils Store requisitions, raises to Purchase Dept.
Purchase Department	Procurement team	Receives requests from Main

PART C — COMPONENT MANAGEMENT

9 What is a Component?

A Component (also called Raw Component or Raw Material) is a part or material used to assemble a finished product. For example: "LabCare OPS Central Cable", "Battery Pack", "Sensor Unit". Components are stocked in the Store and Main Store, supplied by Vendors, and consumed during Factory assembly.

Key idea: Components are what you buy and store. Products are what you build using components. You must add components before you can link them to a product BOM.

10 Add a New Component — Steps

14. Click "Add New Component".
15. Fill in all component details (see Section 16 for field guide).
16. Upload a component image (optional).
17. Upload a component brochure/datasheet (optional).

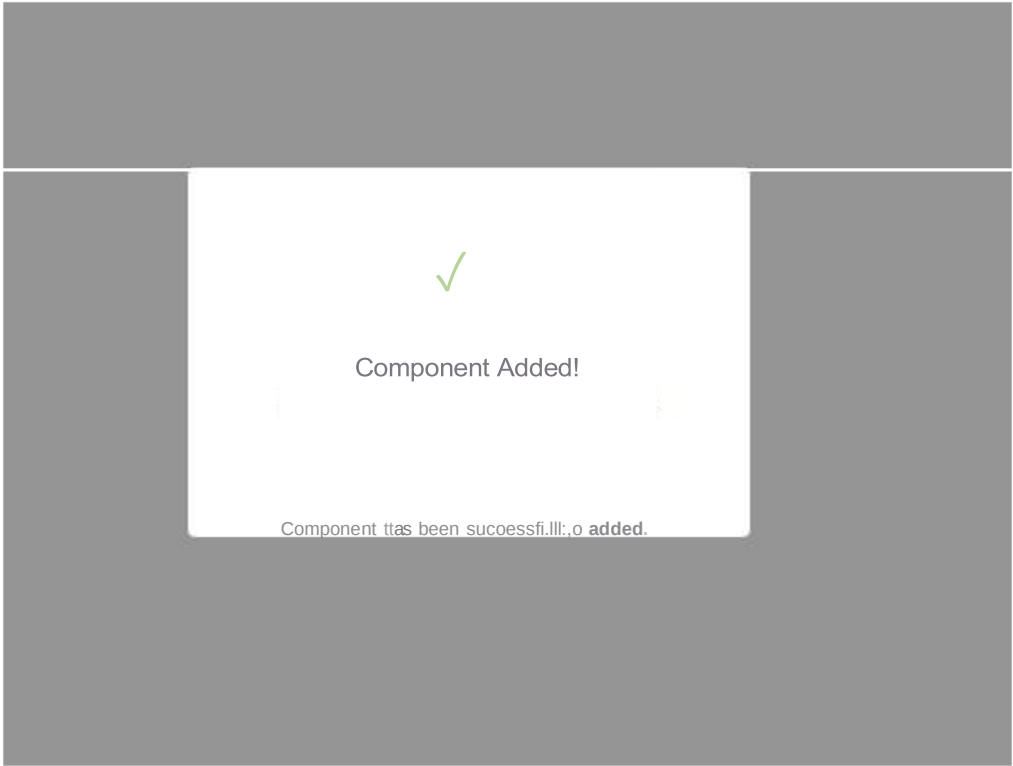

PART D — PRODUCT MANAGEMENT

12 What is a Product?

A Product in LabCare OPS Central is a finished item that the company sells to hospitals. For example: "LabCare OPS Central Kit". Products are assembled at the factory using components (raw materials). Each product has its own Bill of Materials (BOM) — a list of components required to make it.

Key idea: Products are what you sell. Components are what you use to build them. You must add components first, then create the product and link the required components to it.

13 Add a New Product — Steps

20. Click "Products" from the Configuration menu.
21. Click "Add New Product".
22. Fill in all product details (see Section 12 for field guide).
23. Upload a product image (JPG, PNG, WEBP — optional).
24. Upload a product brochure (PDF, DOC, XLSX — optional).
25. In the Components (BOM) section, select the components required to assemble this product and enter the quantity needed for each.

Why add components to a product? When a Floor Person assembles this product on the Floor User Monitor Dashboard, the system knows exactly which components they must scan. The BOM list is what appears on the Floor User Monitor Dashboard screen during assembly.

15 What is a Factory?

A Factory is a manufacturing location where products are assembled. Each factory has its own staff (Factory users and Floor Persons), receives component requisitions, assembles products, and dispatches finished goods to stores. A factory must be set up in the system before you can assign Factory users or create requisitions for it.

16 Add a New Factory — Steps

28. Click "Factories" from the Configuration menu.
29. Click "Add New Factory".
30. Fill in all factory details (see Section 20).
31. Select the Primary User — the person responsible for this factory (must be an existing user in the system).
32. Select the Products that this factory is authorised to assemble, and set the MOQ (Minimum Order Quantity) for each product.
33. Click Save.
34. The factory is now active and Factory users can be assigned to it.

PART F — STORE MANAGEMENT

19 What is a Store?

A Store is a physical location that holds product and component inventory, fulfils hospital orders, and handles inward/outward operations. A store is linked to one or more factories. Store Persons are assigned to stores and can only see data for their assigned store.

Example: Pune Store receives an order for 10 LabCare OPS Central Kits. The Store checks its inventory. If the product is available, it outwards directly. If not, it raises a requisition to the linked factory.

20 Add a New Store — Steps

35. Click "Stores" from the Configuration menu.
36. Click "Add New Store".
37. Fill in the store details (see Section 24).
38. Select the Primary User — the Store Person responsible for this store.
39. Link the Factory or Factories that supply products to this store.
40. Click Save.
41. Store Persons can now be assigned to this store via User Management.

PART G — VENDOR MANAGEMENT

23 What is a Vendor?

A Vendor is a supplier company that provides components to your company. When the Main Store runs out of a component, the Purchase Department orders from a Vendor. Vendors are registered in the system so that inward records can reference which vendor supplied which component, and you can track component prices per vendor.

Example: Vendor "Labcorp Supplies Pvt Ltd" supplies LabCare OPS Central Cable to your Main Store. When an inward is created from the Purchase Department, the vendor is selected so the source is recorded.

24 Add a New Vendor — Steps

42. Click "Vendors" from the Configuration menu.
43. Click "Add New Vendor".
44. Fill in the vendor details (see Section 28).
45. Select the Products this vendor supplies (if any).
46. Select the Components this vendor supplies (if any).
47. Click Save.
48. The vendor appears in vendor dropdowns when creating purchase inward records.

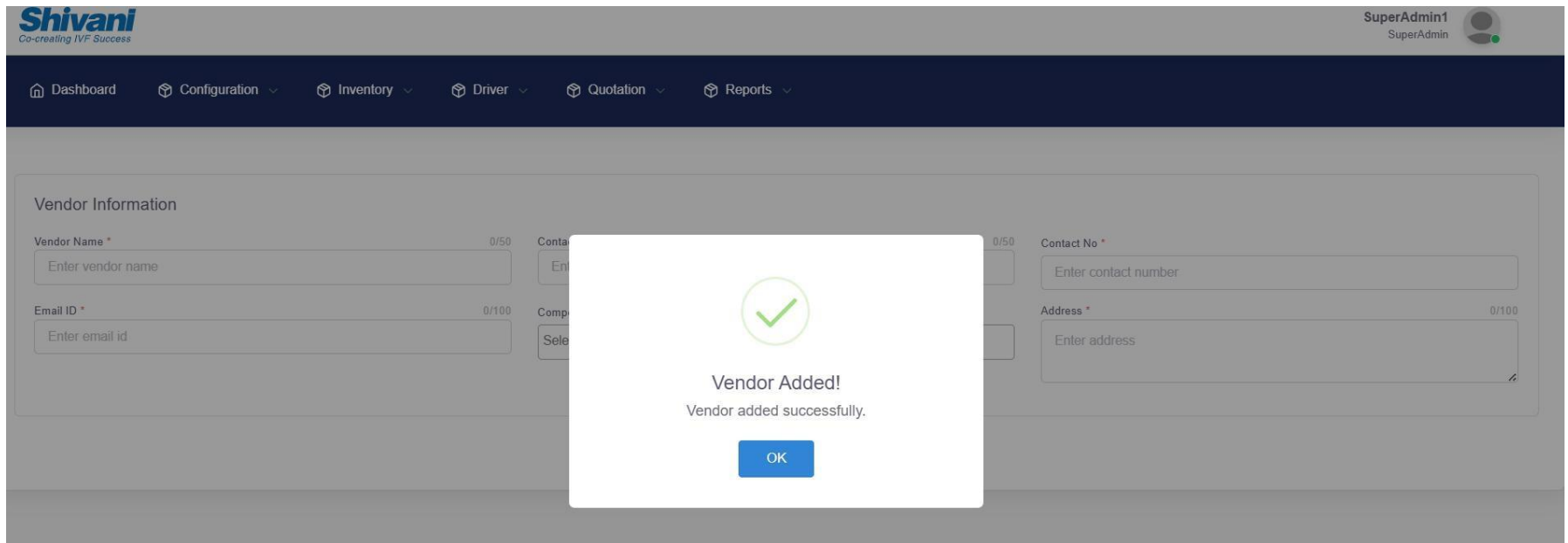
